Cuba Vision Trip -- February 6-14, 2015

Join The Outreach Foundation's Associate Director, Marilyn Borst, for a unique journey to Cuba for pastors and leaders of smaller congregations. Time will be divided between Matanzas and Havana. Learn from church leaders and visit congregations of the Presbyterian Reformed Church in Cuba.

Haiti Vision Trip -- February 27-March 2, 2015

Travel with us to see the dynamic, holistic work of our partner in Port-au-Prince, Haiti Outreach Ministries. Through their congregations, schools, clinics, training and construction programs, HOM is changing lives, shaping families, and rebuilding communities. Led by Rick Wesley, trustee, and Tom Widmer, director of development. \$750 for international airfare and all ground costs.

Mozambique, Tete Province -- June 8-18, 2015

For more than a decade, The Outreach Foundation has helped to facilitate a creative holistic evangelism project in Tete Province that demonstrates God's love through churches, schools, clinics, water projects, health initiatives, leader training, and more. Nearly seventy congregations have been established. Trip leaders will be project director Rev. Nedson Zulu, public health nurse Sebber Banda, and Outreach trustees Berry Long and Tom McDow. Ground costs approximately \$1,850.

China: Seminary Students Study Tour -- June 22-July 4, 2015

This study tour for seminary students will focus on the training ministry of the Chinese Christian Church in a variety of settings, providing opportunities to share faith and build relationships with Chinese students and leaders. We'll visit Shanghai, Nanjing, Xian and Beijing. Led by Outreach's China Mission Specialist Dr. Peter Lim, the estimated cost is \$3,600.

Lebanon: Faithful Women on the Road -- July 24-July 31, 2015

We invite you to consider joining a group of women from Presbyterian churches around the U.S. on a unique mission vision journey to learn about and build personal relationships with

Presbyterian women from Syria and Lebanon. Led by Marilyn Borst, The Outreach Foundation's Associate Director for Partnership Development, we'll depart on July 24th and return July 31st. LAND COST: \$1,760 and includes lodging (double occupancy), meals, sightseeing and transportation. It does not include round trip airfare. Brazil Church Planting Conference -- August 21-September 1, 2015

Join with others to experience the commitment of our Brazilian partners to church planting as a key vehicle for sharing the Gospel. Hear from church visionaries, learn from practitioners and spend time exploring how God is at work in Brazil. Jeff Ritchie and Jose Carlos Pezini will lead this trip.

China: Presbyterian Heritage Tour -- October 19-31, 2015

Throughout this discovery trip to a country where the church today is growing in unparalleled ways, we will meet with partners to discern how God's Spirit has worked in the past and is working today through a dynamic and vital church. Rev. Dr. Peter Lim, Outreach's China Mission Specialist, will lead this trip.

Rwanda: Emerging Leaders -- October 19-31, 2015

Outreach Executive Director Rob Weingartner and Projects Coordinator Ebralie Mwizerwa will lead a group of younger pastors to experience the faith and faithfulness of African Christians who have much to teach us about pastoral vocation and missional calling. Seeing how the gospel is being lived out in the African context will help participants to see their own ministry in creative, new ways. Estimated cost: \$2,900; partial scholarship assistance is available.

India: Kolhapur Mission Conference -- November 8-17, 2015

The Kolhapur Christian Council in Maharashtra has a bold vision for church planting. The trip, led by associate director Jeff Ritchie, will include time with the KCC at their exciting annual mission conference and opportunity to see other ways in which God is at work through the church in India.
