South Sudan: Early 2015

The Outreach Foundation is working with U.S. and international partners to discern how best to come alongside Presbyterian partners in South Sudan. We anticipate a South Sudan trip led by Associate Director Jeff Ritchie to meet the Presbyterian Church of South Sudan and see how they are tackling the challenges of evangelism, development, and peacemaking. Cuba Vision Trip: February 6-14, 2015

Leaders of Smaller Congregations

Join The Outreach Foundation's Associate Director, Marilyn Borst, and the Fellowship Community's Executive Director, the Rev. Dr. Paul Detterman, for a unique journey to Cuba for pastors and leaders of smaller congregations. Time will be divided between Matanzas and Havana. Learn from church leaders and visit congregations of the Presbyterian Reformed Church in Cuba. Estimated basic trip cost is \$1,500 (double occupancy).

Haiti Vision Trip: February 27-March 2, 2015

Travel with us to see the dynamic, holistic work of our partner in Port-au-Prince, Haiti Outreach Ministries. Through their congregations, schools, clinics, training and construction programs, HOM is changing lives, shaping families, and rebuilding communities. Led by Rick Wesley, trustee, and Tom Widmer, director of development. \$750 for international airfare and all ground costs.

Iraq Partner Consultation: May 15-23, 2015

Outreach has long, deep relationships with Presbyterian partners in Iraq, and this trip will afford participants the opportunity to gather in Erbil to encourage and learn from the Iraqi church's faithful witnesses. Supporters of the Iraq Appeal through The Outreach Foundation will have a chance to meet the Presbyterians who are heroically serving their displaced neighbors.

Mozambique: June 8-22, 2015

For more than a decade, The Outreach Foundation has helped to facilitate a creative holistic evangelism project in Tete Province that demonstrates God's love through churches, schools, clinics, water projects, health initiatives, leader training, and more. Nearly seventy congregations have been established. Trip leaders will be project director Rev. Nedson Zulu, public health nurse Sebber Banda, and Outreach trustees Berry Long and Tom McDow. Ground costs approximately \$1,550.

Lebanon and Syria: August

The National Evangelical Synod of Syria and Lebanon, the extension of our Presbyterian family in the region, is based in Beirut which will be our base, as well. This visit of solidarity provides opportunity for congregations and individuals who have supported the Syria Relief Appeal through The Outreach Foundation to experience the situation firsthand and to learn from Synod leaders.

Brazil Church Planting Conference: August

Join with others to experience the commitment of our Brazilian partners to church planting as a key vehicle for sharing the Gospel. Hear from church visionaries, learn from practitioners and spend time exploring how God is at work in Brazil.

Holy Land: October 20-November 2

The focus of this trip will be on connecting with Bethlehem Bible College, Musalaha and the Palestinian Bible Society, meeting with other Palestinian Christian ministries, and visiting important places from Christ's life and ministry. Marilyn Borst will lead this trip. LAND COST: \$2,450, double occupancy.

India: Kolhapur Mission Conference: November 3-17

The Kolhapur Christian Council in Maharashtra has a bold vision for church planting. The trip, led by associate director Jeff Ritchie, will include time with the KCC at their exciting annual mission conference and opportunity to see other ways in which God is at work through the church in India.
