

### **Iraq- October 18-29, 2016**

Come and meet the faithful Presbyterian churches in Basrah and Kirkuk, and, if the security situation allows, in Baghdad. Led by Marilyn Borst, Outreach's Associate Director, and Nuhad Tomeh, Outreach's Consultant for the Middle East, this mission-vision trip will also make time to visit ministry outreach sites in Northern Iraq, where thousands of Christians have had to begin new lives after being displaced by ISIS in June of 2014.

### **Young Adult Equipping Conference- India- November 2016**

The Outreach Foundation has a new partner in western India, the Kolhapur Church Council. Last year our visiting team participated in a church-wide mission conference. Leading in song and worship were dozens of young adults. They have asked us to return to India next fall for a spiritual retreat and to equip them for ministry. Are you part of an active college or young adult group, or are you a leader in young adult ministries in your church? Then this trip may be for you.

### **Guatemala- November 2016**

Travel with The Outreach Foundation to learn more about God's mission in Guatemala. The trip will be led by Outreach's Executive Director Rob Weingartner. The focus of the trip will be ministries that are developing leaders for the church and developing the capacity of the church, especially among the indigenous Q'eqchi' people. We will visit Cobán, Chiséc, Purulhá and Guatemala City.

### **Pakistan- November 7-17, 2016**

Associate Director Marilyn Borst will lead this trip to learn from and encourage partners in one of the most difficult places to be a Christian. We will be based on the secure campus of one of those partners--Forman Christian College--where we will meet with students and faculty. Day trips will be made to visit the Presbyterian seminary in Gujranwala, as well as villages where the Presbyterian Church in Pakistan gives brave witness to the Good News.

## Encounters with the Global Church

### **Cuba Vision Trips- February 5-13 and February 12-20, 2016 (Trips are closed; watch for 2017 Cuba trips)**

Join The Outreach Foundation's Associate Director, Marilyn Borst for two unique journeys to Cuba. The groups will stay mainly in Matanzas but will also spend several nights in Havana. We'll learn from church leaders and explore partnership possibilities with congregations of the Presbyterian Reformed Church in Cuba.

### **Haiti- March 3-7, 2016**

Come join us and see what the Lord is doing in Haiti. Led by Outreach Mission Advocate Rev. Dr. Jay Coker, we will be hosted by Haiti Outreach Ministries leaders and will stay in Port-au-Prince. We'll visit and experience the ministries in several of the poorest districts of Port-au-Prince, visit congregations, primary schools, feeding programs and home rebuilding projects. Trip application deadline is February 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### **Holy Land Mission-Vision Trip- - May 2016**

Join The Outreach Foundation's Associate Director, Marilyn Borst in the Holy Land where we'll be hosted by our partners at Bethlehem Bible College, Musalaha and the Palestinian Bible Society. We'll have ample time to experience the sites of the biblical narrative and places where Christ's life and ministry became incarnational including Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Nazareth and the Galilee, as well as Jericho, the Dead Sea and Qumran.

### **Rebuilding Hope in South Sudan: A Vision Trip to Ethiopia and South Sudan- May 2016**

Civil war in South Sudan caused millions to flee to refugee camps in neighboring Ethiopia. Join Jeff Ritchie and Sudanese American Presbyterians on a trip to meet South Sudanese in refugee camps in Ethiopia. If the war is over and peace is being implemented, we will also travel to Juba, South Sudan, to meet the leadership of the Presbyterian Church of South Sudan, our partner in mission for the rebuilding of hope in the country of South Sudan.

### **Mozambique- June 6-16, 2016**

For more than a decade, The Outreach Foundation has helped to facilitate a creative holistic evangelism project in Tete Province that demonstrates God's love through churches, schools, clinics, water projects, leader training, and much more. Over seventy congregations have been established. Trip leaders will be project director Rev. Nedson Zulu, public health nurse Sebber Banda, and Outreach trustees Berry Long and Tom McDow.

### **Brazil Church Planting Conference- August 24 - Sept 2, 2016**

Join with others to experience the commitment of our Brazilian partners to church planting as a key vehicle for sharing the Gospel. Hear from church visionaries, learn from practitioners and spend time exploring how God is at work in Brazil. José Carlos Pezini and Rob Weingartner will lead this trip.

### **South Korea: Emerging Leaders- October 5-14, 2016**

This opportunity is offered to young pastors, emerging Presbyterian leaders who have been in pastoral ministry for a decade or less. The purpose of this trip is to listen and learn from the South Korean church leaders who are impacting their nation and the world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We'll have meetings with pastors, local congregations, young adults, theologians and other key leaders who are bringing change and transformation within their context. Rob Weingartner and Jeff Ritchie will lead this trip.

### **China: Presbyterian Heritage Discovery Trip- October 16-29, 2016**

Since 2000 The Outreach Foundation has been helping Presbyterians discover the Church in China and the legacy of Presbyterian mission there. We will learn how Christianity began in China in Xi'an, where Presbyterian missions were concentrated, and-most important- how the Church in China is growing and thriving today. Our itinerary will take us to Shanghai, Suzhou, Nanjing, Xi'an and Beijing. Jeff Ritchie will lead this trip.

### **Egypt- October 18-29, 2016**

Egypt is a land with a long, grand and diverse history; this history includes the amazing stories of God's church. We will also visit new church developments in the 'suburbs' and 'satellite cities' around Cairo, meet current and future church leaders, and be inspired by the church's bold and progressive mission vision even as our presence there will encourage local Christians. Outreach's Director of Development Tom Widmer and trustee Nancy Fox will lead this trip.
