Whether fleeing from war, political upheaval, religious persecution, or natural disasters, many families leave their homes and everything they know in order to seek safety. More than 89 million people, with about 40% of those children, have been forcibly displaced from their homes, and more than 27 million of them are considered refugees. having fled their home country. We have partners in many difficult places who provide food and medicine, shelter, trauma counseling, job training, educational opportunities, discipleship training, and Bibles to these displaced persons who may not even have a home to which they can return.
